

The Square Camberley Terms & Conditions and FAQs

Design the Logo for The Community Corner at The Square

- The competition is open to pupils from schools. Both primary, senior, state or private
- Entries must be submitted using the official template form. Entries not submitted on official template may not be considered
- The pupil's name and school name must be clearly stated on each entry.
- Entries can be submitted individually or as a group.
- There is no limit to the number of entries a school may submit.
- Entries must be received by 5pm on Friday 5th June. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Entries must be submitted to the Customer Service Desk at The Square Shopping Centre.

Judging

- Entries will be judged by a panel including representatives from The Square Shopping Centre and their marketing agency.
- The winning design will be selected based on creativity, suitability and how well it represents the Community Corner concept.
- The judges reserve the right to adapt or refine the winning design for practical use.
- If no suitable entry is received, The Square reserves the right not to select a winner.

Winner Contact

- The winning school will be contacted by telephone.
- If contact cannot be made, The Square will attempt to reach the school via their publicly listed office email address.
- The winner will be announced by Friday 12th June. Announced on The Square Camberley's official Facebook, Instagram, website and newsletter.

Prize

- The winning pupil will receive a prize bundle (details to be confirmed).
- The winning school will receive £1,000 for their art department.
- The £1,000 will be paid within 60 days of initial contact.

Usage & Rights

- By entering the competition, participants agree that the submitted design becomes the property of The Square Shopping Centre.
- The selected logo may be used across signage, marketing materials and digital platforms.
- The winner will have no claim over the future use or reproduction of the design.

- The winner must agree to photography and publicity for PR and marketing purposes.
- The Square has the right to change the date of competition closure.

Entries

- All entries, or a selection of entries, may be displayed within The Square Shopping Centre.
- The Square is not obligated to notify schools or entrants if their work is displayed.
- Due to the volume of entries expected, submissions cannot be returned or collected.
- The Square will not cover the costs of any entries being posted.

FAQs

- Who can enter?
Local school pupils can enter either through their school or independently.
- Can pupils work together?
Yes, entries can be created individually or as a group.
- Is there a limit to entries?
No, schools or individuals can submit as many entries as they wish.
- What should the design include?
The wording “Community Corner at The Square” and a visual representation of community.
- What materials can be used?
Designs should be created using felt tip, colouring pencils or similar hand-drawn methods.
- Where do we submit entries?
Entries must be dropped off at the Customer Service Desk at The Square Shopping Centre.
- When is the deadline?
Friday 5th June at 5pm.
- When will the winner be announced?
By Friday 12th June. Announced on The Square Camberley’s official Facebook, Instagram, website and newsletter.
- Will all entries be displayed?
Not all entries will necessarily be displayed, and The Square may choose a selection.
- Will entries be returned?
No, entries cannot be returned due to the high volume expected.
- Who owns the winning design?
The Square Shopping Centre will own the final logo and its usage rights.
